BEFORE THE BIG DAY

We encourage anyone considering Treehouse Point for their elopement to schedule a preliminary site visit. However, do not fret if you are not able to visit Treehouse Point prior to your big day, our staff and vendors are experts at coordinating from afar!



Once you have decided our venue is “the one,” we will create a contract for you. You will then have two weeks to return the contract, along with a 25% deposit to hold the date. The final payment is not due until four weeks prior to your wedding day.

After receiving your contract and deposit, we will send you additional information and put you in touch with our wonderful elopement vendors. We also provide a handy checklist with information regarding any items required before your celebration of love.





YOUR ELOPEMENT DAY



Upon arriving at Treehouse Point you will be greeted by your elopement coordinator. They will check you in for your overnight stay and show you to your treehouse. If you have not previously visited the venue, you will take a quick walk around the property to choose a ceremony location.

Your treehouse and The Cedar Suite will be available for you to get dressed and ready for your photos and ceremony. We recommend doing your hair and makeup prior to arriving at Treehouse Point so you can maximize your time here.

Your Elopement Coordinator will connect with you before your photos and ceremony to collect your marriage license and answer any additional questions you might have.

MOSSY ARCH

Ceremonies at the river are held under the beautiful mossy arch. The arch is a great location for intimate ceremonies of 6 people or less, standing room only.



LOWER LAWN

Ceremonies on the lower lawn are held year round when the weather is just right. You are welcome to add floral and decor to our chairs and our rustic wooden arbor or to simply let the lush forest speak for itself.

POND ROOM

Ceremonies may also be held inside our cedar-lined Pond Room. This space is an ideal ceremony location for a small intimate group or in off season months.
